


Van Gogh - Monet - Manet - Degas Renoir - Toulouse-Lautrec - Gauguin







**Impressionism** developed in France in the nineteenth century and is based on the practice of painting out of doors and spontaneously 'on the spot' rather than in a studio from sketches. Main impressionist subjects were landscapes and scenes of everyday life.

**The Exhibition** is composed of multiples activities, combines panels that tell the story of the artists and the period, reproductions of each artist's most famous works, and interconnected immersion galleries that combine projection of artworks and emotive music.



## **Monet's Dream**

In the small town of **Giverny** there lies **Monet's garden.**In this magical place that Monet personally designed and developed, everything has been arranged in such a way that he could paint it, by finding amid that nature the lights and colours representing the essential elements for his canvases

He envisaged it as a place where he could paint in peace, away from the rest of the world. Light and shadows, reflections on the water, movements created by the wind, and the sun's rays cutting through the foliage. Tranquillity, reflection, and emotion – everything merges within a dream-like atmosphere.

'My garden is my finest masterpiece', Monet wrote. Today, in this room, we can relive that dream.







The immersive room dedicated to Parisian life and leisure add an authentic level of connection to the artists' lives.

The space inspired by 'The Moulin Rouge' Theater in Paris with a large screen forming a theatrical backdrop, shows through paintings life and free time between the mid and late nineteenth century, a period of great changes that impressionist art testifies to in his canvases.
